

JOB TITLE: *TA Subject Intervention*

RESPONSIBLE TO: *Senior Curriculum Leader*

Job Purpose: To work collaboratively with teaching staff to plan and provide effective small group interventions within their subject area which lead to improved outcomes for students.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES

1.	Plan and deliver interventions which impact directly on student performance.
2.	Plan and implement agreed learning activities for individual and groups of students, in collaboration with the teaching staff, to ensure that learning objectives and individual learning targets are achieved.
3.	Co-ordinate the departmental intervention process. Monitor and report its impact on student outcomes.
4.	Observe and monitor individual students, to provide accurate assessments of progress, and problem areas for the compilation of reports and to provide appropriate feedback to students, parents and other staff.
5.	Liaise with parents/carers and other professional staff and outside agencies to ensure effective communication concerning the maintenance of students' well-being + progress.
6.	Access and update the full range of student records to facilitate assessment of students' progress.
7.	Prepare and maintain intervention resources (including control of stock within the classroom) so that they are readily available for use.
8.	Display and present the student' work so that it enhances the classroom environment and celebrates achievement.
9.	Supervise the activities of individual or groups of students, both in and out of the classroom (including educational visits), to ensure their safety and facilitate their physical and emotional development in accordance with the school's managing behaviour strategies.
10.	Attend staff and other meetings and participate in staff training development work and staff reviews as required

Notwithstanding the detail in this job description, in accordance with the School's/Council's Flexibility Policy the job holder will undertake such work as may be determined by the Headteacher/Governing Body from time to time, up to or at a level consistent with the Main Responsibilities of the job.
