School clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plain white long/short-sleeved shirt *Blazers are compulsory and must be black with the school badge Trousers- must be school style tailored and plain black and can be worn by all students *Skirts must be the grey checked Trutex and worn to an appropriate length Plain black tailored school shorts (*new option) *Ties- compulsory and must be of appropriate length showing school badge and House colours for yr7-10 Plain black v-neck knitted pullover Ankle or knee-high socks must be black. Tights should be plain black. <p>The school reception have embroidered blazer badges available to collect, which can be ironed or sewn onto a black blazer. £3 on collection</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fashion shirts or those with emblems on Blazer sleeves rolled up, no tailored or fashion jackets Fashion trousers, jeans, cords, tracksuit bottoms or leggings Ties worn short or inappropriately (e.g. with no school badge visible) Fashion cardigans or pullovers, hoodies, crew neck pullovers, sweatshirts or emblems on clothing Skirts must not be rolled up No brightly-coloured socks No patterned tights or leg warmers No belts on skirts
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conventional style and cut Natural colours only At least number 3 or above at the back and sides (if hair is longer on top) Number 4 or above in length (all over) Clean and neat Simple bobble to tie hair back Clean shaven 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hair below a grade 4 Patterns or wedges shaved into the head Extreme styles / Buzz cuts /closely shaved all over Coloured hair- including highlights, streaks, red or jet-black colouring and bleaching Hair decorations Fastened in braids or extensions Beading and coloured hair wraps or bright/large bands, clips or bows No beards (Years 7-11)

PE Kit : All students are required to have the logoed short-sleeved polo.

The boys also need for football and rugby the relevant House Rugby top. (The school hoodie cannot be worn for these sports)
Students can wear an extra optional logoed Navy Hoodie or the navy and white fitted long sleeved training top (no other kind can be worn)

Students should wear a pair of plain navy shorts/skort/ leggings/ training trousers (these can be purchased from the uniform shops or other outlets at low cost.) *Items marked with an asterisk (*) are available from The Uniform Shop or Uniformity.*

All jewellery and all metal piercings must be removed for all PE lessons.

<p>Plain non-branded navy leggings, joggers or shorts/skort.</p>	
<p>Football boots, shin pads & gum shield</p>	<p>For football and rugby lessons. All students will do football.</p>
<p>Trainers</p>	<p>Training shoes with good grips and non-marking soles not pumps or Converse. They can be any colour. Moschino style elastic fashion shoes are not allowed at all as they do not support the ankle.</p>
<p>PE Bag</p>	<p>PE bags should be waterproof and big enough to fit all PE items in.</p>
